La Chapelle-sur-Furieuse, Jura

Morgane Turlier is one of the most promising young winemakers in the Jura today.

Morgane farms just under a hectare of old vines of Chardonnay, Savagnin and Trousseau planted over a mix of limestone and Jurassic marl in the commune of Marnoz.

Working several days a week for Etienne Thiebaud of Domaine des Cavarodes, Morgane has a sensitive approach to farming. The vines are worked by horse and treated with nothing more than a little copper, sulphur and herbal teas.

In the cellar she adds nothing and takes nothing away, producing delicate, pure wines with a beautiful sense of place. If her first vintages are anything to go by, the future is bright for this talented vigneronne.

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VIGNES AUX LOUPS
2020

A blend of Trousseau and Poulsard from old vines near Morgane's cellar in La Chapelle-sur-Furieuse. The grapes were destemmed, fermented together on the skins for a month and then were aged for nine months in old barrels. From a warmer vintage, this incredibly lifted and energetic, with brambly fruit, earth and spice mixing to wonderful effect.
